

# Report Builder - CRM Reporting Model

The CRM reporting model allows you to retrieve all company, contact and associated project data via Microsoft Report Builder. The following is a guide to all of the entities and their fields within this model, as well as the relationships that link them together.

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### **Creating custom reports using Report Builder**

Report Builder is a Microsoft reporting tool that allows you to create custom reports specific to your business requirements. ### **Report Builder support**

Unfortunately due to the inherent flexibility and complicated nature of reporting software, we do not offer free telephone support for Report Builder. We strongly suggest that clients attend a classroom course in the first instance, followed by one-one training if necessary depending on your reporting requirements. 

#### **CRM Model Overview**

The following diagram shows an overview of the CRM reporting model and the way in which its entities are related:



Data can be retrieved by one entity from another providing that there is a link between them, but these entities do not have to be directly linked.


For example, you could retrieve all project contacts at a specific client by using the name value from the Client entity, and the name value from the ProjectContact entity. You would not have to use fields from the project entity, but if you did then it would group the contacts by project.





# Company

The company entity contains both client and supplier data, and contains only those fields which are applicable to both.

# Company > Client

This entity contains fields which are specific to clients. Name and address data for client's is found in the company entity. Clients are then linked to projects.

### **Company > Contact**

This entity contains contact data. Contacts that have been specifically set as project contacts can also be found in the project contact entity. Contacts are usually linked to a company, but can also exist without being linked to a company.

This entity contains project data, including summary and fee information. Projects are linked to clients and project contacts. Any other data associated with projects, such as tasks and time, is only available within the project reporting model.
